

Wine Glass Lamp Shade Tutorial

Tools and Supplies:

8-1/2" x 11" Translucent Vellum Paper

Stamps

New Flat Pencil Eraser

Heat tool

Pigment Ink Pads (like ColorBox, Versa Ink, or Brilliance brand)

Embossing Powder (Judikins or Ranger are good brands)

1/8" Mini brads

Instructions:

1: Trace and cut out the shade.

2: Stamp image in the center of the shade. Stamp border along edge with pencil eraser.

While ink is still wet, cover with embossing powder, shake off excess. Heat with heat tool until powder is melted and becomes shiny.

Tip: For a richer, deeper design, match the color of your pigment ink and embossing powder.

3: Bring the ends together, overlapping. Punch holes at the top and bottom of the shade, through both layers. Insert decorative brads.

Variations:

Cut the shade out of pretty scrapbooking paper. Wicked easy!

For added sparkle, apply stick on crystal accents on the pretty paper.

Tip: Don't buy colored adhesive crystals. Get the clear ones, and then use permanent ink pens (Sharpies, etc.) to color the gems whatever color you need!



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
